

### What are Mini Fairs?



A series of small, expo-style high school presentations for 8th-grade students during school day, with a parent night the final evening.

- WHY: Connect with 8<sup>th</sup> graders and inform them of all their 9<sup>th</sup>-grade options for next year!
- WHERE: Middle schools and 1 academy. Additional event for families at ACC the evening of the last Mini Fair.
- WHO: Representatives from each high school program will visit each host site.
- WHEN: Jan. 8-12, 22-26, 29

**Required events.** All 9<sup>th</sup>-grade offerings need to present each day. All campuses ending with 8th grade need to participate.

### Logistics & Set-up




- 18 High School + 1 Dual Language tables = 19 stations for rotation
- Each high school/program will have 1 table and 2 chairs
- 2 OAES tables for welcome/materials
- SAISD Wi-Fi available. Limited electrical outlets bring fully-charged devices (optional: extension cord)
- OAES staff will be on hand to assist with setup, receive presenters, buses, etc.

- OAES will visit each host site the day before at 3:45 PM to review set-up and deliver materials.
- Presenters arrive by 9:00 AM / 12:30 PM and sign in at front office.
- All Mini Fairs are in school gyms

### **Grouping & Rotations**

- OAES will determine groupings and rotation schedule.
- Table signs with table # will facilitate table rotations.
- Students will rotate in small groups (<10) to each station.</li>
- Each station rotation is 4 minutes long.
- OAES will direct rotations with stopwatch and megaphone.
- If any student misses a station, they will still get information for each program in a Mini Fair packet.
- Additional campus staff members need to be on site to provide support.
   OAES will also assist.



### **Host Sites**

- Host sites are all the middle schools and one academy.
- All sites are listed on the Mini Fair calendar for each event date.
- The OAES will contact custodians and conduct walkthroughs the afternoon prior to the event at 3:45 pm.

### Transportation

- Bus transportation will be provided at no cost to campus
- Campuses will provide OAES with completed Bus Request form (field trip request).
  OAES will then submit all forms to Transportation
- Campuses need to secure field trip permission forms and keep on campus.
- AM pick-up time 9:00 am / Arrival time 9:30-9:45 per location / Return time 12:15
- PM pick-up time 12:00 pm / Arrival time 12:30-12:40 per location / Return time 3:00
- Chaperone recommended on each bus
- Avoid leaving personal belongings on bus








### **ACTION ITEMS: 8th-grade campuses**

  - Upload your completed form into <u>this Google</u> folder by Tues., Dec. 12




