- o Discuss your career and college plans
- o Sign up for the PSAT in September for the October School Day PSAT
- o Plan your senior year in the spring
- o Enroll and attend summer school classes, if necessary
- o See if you qualify for fee waivers for college admissions, PSAT, SAT and ACT
- o Sign up for the SAT and ACT for the Spring and Summer of your junior year

□ Explore colleges of interest by...

- o Visiting our campus College & Career HUB
- o Attending college fairs
- o Searching colleges & career exploration via SchooLinks and/or the internet
- o Visiting college campuses
- o Researching majors and careers
- o Narrowing a list of colleges you wish to attend
- Review your PSAT scores in December and find teachers or tutors to help you improve your weak areas - <u>KHAN Academy</u> and <u>Cafe College</u> are great resources as well
- □ Use free online tutoring for SAT and ACT
- Sign up for AP tests and the SAT and ACT in the spring of your junior year
- □ Take the ASVAB to explore career choices in November
- Continue to begin extracurricular activities, sports and volunteer work

- □ Athletes should file with NCAA clearinghouse
