## SENIOR CHECKLIST



### □ September

- o Check with your counselor to ensure that your classes meet with your career and college goals
- o Be sure to stay on top of grades & attendance
- o Gather applications and deadlines for applying to colleges
- o If applying for a 4-year school, sign-up for tests like the ACT and SAT
- o If remaining in Texas for college, be sure you are college ready in Reading, Writing and Math on SAT, ACT and/or TSI; if not, talk to your counselor about resources to help you achieve college readiness
- o Research colleges and financial aid information online and through our campus College & Career HUB
- o Ask for fee waivers if you qualify for free and reduced lunch for SAT and ACT
- o Attend fall college fair

#### □ October

- o Ask your teachers and counselor to write letters of recommendation be sure to provide them with a <u>resume</u>
- o Edit or write your personal statement for college admission requirements
- o Attend a Financial Aid workshop to have our campus college bound advisors assist with completing your FAFSA or TASFA
- o Continue to monitor your grades and attendance

#### □ November

- o Submit admission applications to 4-year colleges or other post-secondary institutions
- o Continue to monitor your grades and attendance

#### □ December

- o Continue to monitor your grades and attendance
- o Complete College & Career HUB Fall Senior Checklist
- o Deadline to take the SAT or ACT for some colleges
- o Visit college campuses during winter break

## □ January

- o Register for the AP exams you intend to take, if not already done
- o Continue to monitor your grades and attendance

## □ February

- o Continue researching for scholarship opportunities
- o The FAFSA must be filed no later than the first week of March
- o Continue to monitor your grades and attendance

#### □ March

- o Continue to monitor your grades and attendance
- o Plan you summer work, internships and/or community service experiences

## □ April

- o Continue to monitor your grades and attendance
- o Register for summer classes, if needed
- o Finalize and plan for your college financial aid needs
- o Notify your counselor and college bound advisor what college you will be attending

## □ May

- o Continue to monitor your grades and attendance
- o Athletes: To play college sports, you must be certified by the NCAA through the Clearinghouse
- o Enroll in your college's orientation programs

#### □ June

- o Graduation
- o Request your final transcript to be sent to the college/university you will be attending
