



# Routes of the First Americans










### Columbus Comes upon a New World

- Events leading up to discovery of New World
  - Europeans wanted products from Asia
  - Africa provides cheap slave labor
  - Portuguese develop long-range voyages
  - Spain modern nation-state takes shape
  - Renaissance began in 1300s
  - Printing presses (1450) spread knowledge
  - Mariner's compass invented (Arabs?)









The Spanish claimed that the encomienda system would benefit both settlers and Indians. It didn't work out that way.



Spanish settlers protect, care for, and Christianize Indians. Indians work a portion of their time for Spanish settlers.

#### THE REALITY

Spanish settlers force long labor, don't pay Indian workers, fail to protect Indians, and seize Indian lands.

Indians die from disease and harsh living and working conditions.

Encomienda ends after clergy protests and Indians revolt. Abuses continue under replacement repartimiento.

- Why England colonized Americas late
  - Initially allied with Spain so didn't want to compete
  - Henry VIII broke with the Catholic Church, setting off decades-long religious conflict in the nation
  - Famous sea dog pirates (Sir Francis Drake)
- Early 1600s 3 European powers make claims in 3 different parts of North America
  - 1607 English at Jamestown
  - 1608 French at Quebec
  - 1610 Spanish at Santa Fe
