The student will develop kinesthetic awareness, movement memory, creative abilities, and aesthetic appreciation of various dance forms.



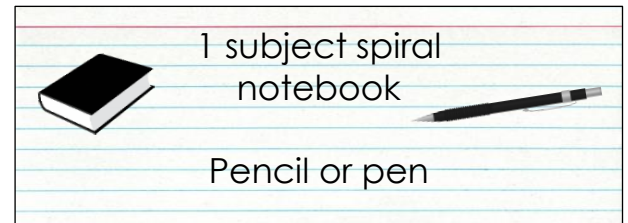

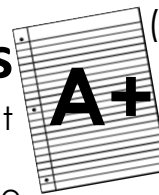

Formative Grades: Written Assignments, Movement Critiques, Daily Class Grade (Dressing Out/Participation)

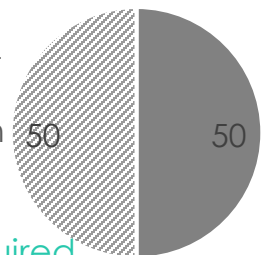
Performance Requirements
