CCMR Accountability and C3 Grant Goals

- 70% of students will graduate college-ready by year 3
- 70% of graduates will enroll in college in the fall after graduation
- 50% of graduates will graduate with an industry credential
- 50% of graduates will attain 12+ hours of dual credit
- 50% of parents at high school/middle school will participate in at least one college/career visit by graduation
- 50% of high school students will participate in one or more work-based learning opportunities
- 50% of parents and students will participate in a work-based learning information session beginning in middle years and continuing through high school
- 80% of middle & high school staff will complete annual professional development focus on college & career programming options & platform usage
- 90% of all middle school students will participate in at least one information session or college or career activity focused on high school and postsecondary options and planning will record participation in SchooLinks
