#### **Leadership Team**

The Leadership team is made up of high-level personnel from the school district, campus, industry/business, and IHE with decision-making authority who meet regularly to report to each organization. The leadership team is responsible for developing long-term strategic priorities for the P-TECH program along with a work plan for how to achieve programmatic goals in coordination with district and campus improvement planning. Regularly scheduled meetings address the following topics:

- Establish and maintain the role each member will play in the design, governance, operations, accountability, curriculum development, professional development, outreach, sustainability, and continuous monitoring and improvement of the P-TECH.. It is the responsibility of the leadership team to oversee the design, governance, operations, accountability, curriculum development, professional development, outreach, sustainability, and continuous monitoring and improvement of Cyber PTECH USA. This leadership team hold the ultimate decision making authority.
- Collectively develop an MOU and review annually for necessary revisions.
- Share responsibility for meeting annual outcomes-based measures and providing annual reports to their district and IHE boards, as well as to the public.
