On these 5 days of programming, we would have the opportunity to work with 9th-12th grade girls. One facilitator(Ms. Cynthia) would work with up to 30 girls in 9th/10th and Ms. Stephanie would work with up to 30 girls in 11th/12th. (Ms. Stephanie and Ms. Cynthia are both Program Managers with our organization who work with our Teen participants)

Programming would include Work-ready skills, such as resume building, branding, building self-confidence, interview skills, communication, presentation, and, as opportunities present themselves, job shadowing, and mentoring with potential internships inside/outside of our agency. Programming will re-enforce and support the PTECH-Business/Dual Credit track of academic learning. Girls Inc would also help to support and encourage the mental health and wellness of all participants through social emotional learning resources. The programming will truly provide all girls the opportunity to be STRONG, SMART, and BOLD. Program Facilitators will also support the completion of a learning project that can be shared and presented during an end of session celebration highlighting the girl's growth, experiences, and accomplishments.

Girls Inc will provide the facilitators, materials, and resources for programming that support the girls' learning, while your team will provide a space(s) for programming to take place equipped with the appropriate furniture/seating/tables to work with large groups of participants.

Additional conversations today include the following;

1. We would share information on upcoming events
2. We would share information for Compudopt distributions and programs as well as contact information for a local Compudopt Program Manager.
3. We would share other Girls Inc Program resources available on our campus at 2214 Basse Rd.
