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

3.2 Documenting Enrollment Procedures

Choice Schools and Magnet Programs offer specialized academic programming designed to best fit the individual interests of students. Admission is based on a lottery system* and is open to all students living in Bexar county and surrounding areas.

Recruitment plan reflection
