First Round of TSI Testing and C3 Action Plan

SAISD TSI Test Window September 9th-12th

Focus Group is Seniors: students and teachers will need to be aware/advised of TSI prep and test dates in advance.

- Top 24 seniors
 - 11 passed Reading will be exempted from TSI reading and writing of their ELAR score. And will not need to be tested
 - 24 will need to do the math portion.
 - PLAN:
 - 9-9 (Monday) is to have Good Sam and Mrs. PinDell work together to "Prep" the students that need to on Sept 9 in the morning for ELAR and test in the afternoon.
 - 9-10 (Tuesday) Top 24 students will do "Prep" in the morning for Math and test in the afternoon.
- All remaining Seniors will do TSI testing on the 11th and 12th according to recommended <u>TSI Calendar testing dates</u>.
- Senior Parent Meeting to discuss:
 - CBA has a powerpoint presentation with vast information
 - C3 Coach will discuss TSI scores/TSI outcomes and TSI expectations
 - Counselors will also be available to discuss foundations and credit requirements and EOC/ Ranks/Honors grads
 - Senior Class Sponsor
 - Other campus key people will be invited

College Prep Course (s): Student must earn grade >75; may use TSI waiver to attend UTSA or Alamo Colleges & take credit bearing first year courses

Student is within 11 points of TSIA cut score:

- Enroll student in TSIA tutoring or ensure placement in core course where TSIA content standards are addressed (English IV, Algebra II/Senior Math); or Student completes TSIA tutoring sessions (SureScore, campus-based, Edgenuity, Texas College Bridge Alamo Colleges);
- 2. Monitor & retest.

Student is within 12 - 30 points of TSI cut score, and has passed Alg I EOC &/or Eng I & II** EOCs:

- Place in appropriate College Prep Course (ELA 1707/ CP110100 and/or Math 1708/CP111200; note: these courses may count for 4th year ELA and/or 4th year math & use Texas College Bridge (TCB) as the core
 - Students have to complete 8 hours of intervention before they can test:

Math Intervention:

- Math Intervention Plan: Moore will support Math
 - Suleiman & Rodriguez Senior Classes
 - West will support the passers
 - Looking at Edgenuity for record keeping and intervention log
- English Hoover : PInDell will support English

- Dr. Stevens suggested that we use the STAAR EOC intervention about pulling out of their elective classes.
- Also suggested we add a government class added for the additional time frame.
- Plan is to complete the 5 sessions through Government and 5 sessions through senior classes.
