What is an endorsement?

Students in the state of Texas will be able to earn one or more **endorsements** as part of their **graduation** requirements. **Endorsements** consist of a related series of courses that are grouped together by interest or skill set. They provide students with in-depth knowledge of a subject area.

Jefferson High School Endorsement Offerings

Business & Industry –

- *Design & Multi-media Arts:* Explores the occupations and educational opportunities associated with designing or creating graphics to meet specific commercial or promotional needs.
- *Digital Communications:* Explores the occupations and educational opportunities associated with the production of audio and visual media formats for various purposes, such as TV broadcasts, advertising, video production, or motion pictures.
- *Business Management:* Students will learn the skills necessary to formulate policies, manage daily operations, and allocate the use of materials and human resources.
- *Architectural Design:* Explores the occupations and educational opportunities associated with developing, engineering, and designing building structures and facilities.
- *Construction Management & Inspection:* Explores the occupations and educational opportunities associated with cost estimates for construction projects or services to aid management in bidding on or determining the price of products or services.
- *Computer Science:* Explores the occupations and educational opportunities related to planning, implementing, upgrading, or monitoring security measure for the protection of computer networks and information.

Public Service –

- *Healthcare Therapeutic:* Introduces students to occupations and educational opportunities related to diagnosing and treating acute, episodic, or chronic illness.
- *Law Enforcement:* Teaches students about the development of, adherence to, and protection of various branches of law.
- *Teaching & Training:* Prepares students for careers related to teaching, instruction, and creation of instructional and enrichment materials.
