They provide students with in-depth knowledge of a subject area.

#### Jefferson High School Endorsement Offerings

#### Business & Industry -

- Design & Multi-media Arts: Explores the occupations and educational opportunities associated with designing or creating graphics to meet specific commercial or promotional needs.
- Digital Communications: Explores the occupations and educational opportunities associated with the production of audio and visual media formats for various purposes, such as TV broadcasts, advertising, video production, or motion pictures.
- Business Management: Students will learn the skills necessary to formulate policies, manage daily operations, and allocate the use of materials and human resources.
- Architectural Design: Explores the occupations and educational opportunities associated with developing, engineering, and designing building structures and facilities.
- Construction Management & Inspection: Explores the
  occupations and educational opportunities
  associated with cost estimates for construction
  projects or services to aid management in bidding
  on or determining the price of products or services.
- Computer Science: Explores the occupations and educational opportunities related to planning, implementing, upgrading, or monitoring security measure for the protection of computer networks and information.
