

Coca-Cola Scholarship

The 2023 Coca-Cola Scholars Program application deadline is 5 p.m. Eastern on Monday, October 31, 2022

To be eligible for consideration, applicants **must be**:

- Current high school **OR** home-schooled students attending school in one of the 50 U.S. states, the District of Columbia, Puerto Rico, or select DoD schools who will graduate high school during the 2022-2023 academic school year (*students graduating from an American or expat school abroad are not eligible for this award; individuals who have already graduated from high school are not eligible*)
- U.S. Citizens (**not Temporary Residents**), U.S. Nationals, U.S. Permanent Residents, Refugees, Asylees, Cuban-Haitian Entrants, OR Humanitarian Parolees - based on the guidelines utilized by U.S. Department of Education for Federal Financial Aid eligibility
- Planning to pursue a degree at an accredited U.S. college or university

Applicants **may not be**:

- Children or grandchildren of current employees, officers, or owners of Coca-Cola bottling companies, The Coca-Cola Company, Company divisions or subsidiaries
- Children or grandchildren of former employees, officers, or owners of Coca-Cola bottling companies, The Coca-Cola Company, Company divisions or subsidiaries who are currently receiving retirement benefits from those entities
- Students attending school outside of the 50 U.S. states or Puerto Rico (*with the exception of students attending select DoD schools; students graduating from an American or expat school abroad are not eligible for this award, even if they meet the citizenship criteria above*)
- High school graduates (***if you received a high school diploma prior to the 2022-2023 school year, you are not eligible***)
- Temporary Residents (*if your permanent legal residence is outside the U.S., you are not eligible*)
