The School Social Worker attempts to coordinate family, school, and community resources to resolve these needs. Students, parents, or school personnel can request social work services. Most services provided in school are short-term. If a student requires long-term therapeutic services, the social worker will work with parents/guardians to locate appropriate community agencies. The School Social Worker works as part of a team of professionals in the school. This team strives to help students, parents, and school personnel provide the most positive educational experience possible.
