In one year, Jefferson doubled the number of graduates attending Tier I University schools. Jefferson has committed to 25% of graduating seniors attending a Tier I University by 2020 (60% to a 4-year university and 95% college) as part of its "Declaration of Transformation" World-Class 2020 plan.
