This letter is to inform San Antonio ISD that the Texas Education Agency (TEA) has approved the 2019-2020 designation application for St. Philip's College Early College High School with SAISD as an Early College High School (ECHS).

Designation is valid for one school year from the date of this letter and must be renewed annually. Designation allows ECHS to receive technical assistance and participate in the network of ECHS.

The 2019-2020 designation process for ECHS includes reports for OBMs. CCRSM are currently in a phase process for new blueprints. Your campuses ECHS OBM report is available through TEA's TEAL Login. This data is for information and planning purposes only. This information will not be used for 2019-2020 designation. ## TEA Designated Early College High Schools (ECHS)

In the 2015-2016 school year, an ECHS indicator was placed in PEIMS. All designated ECHS must ensure that the required ECHS indicator Code is included as a data element for Submissions 1, 3, and 4. Submission 1 is the fall snapshot date in October (last Friday in October). Please coordinate with the PEIMS coordinator on the campus or at the district regarding specific PEIMS questions.

This document provides information regarding the indicator which is submitted on the Student Extension Complex Type. Additional information regarding submission requirements is here: [TEDS Student Category Data Submission Requirements](#).

- If the designated ECHS is a stand-alone campus (all students on the campus are in the ECHS) – all students should be identified in E1560 with the indicator code of 1.
- If the designated ECHS is a school-within-a school (not all students on the campus are in the ECHS program) then:
  - The students receiving instruction in the ECHS should be identified in E1560 with an indicator of 1.
  - Students not receiving instruction in the ECHS should be identified in E1560 with an indicator of 0.

**ECHS-INDICATOR-CODE (E1560)** indicates whether a student is enrolled in an Early College High School as defined in Texas Administrative Code §102.1091.

The data collection for E1560 will be collected in Submissions 1, 3, and 4.

- **Submission 1** - Students enrolled in ECHS on the last Friday in October (Fall Snapshot date) are reported.
- **Submission 3** - Students enrolled in ECHS at any point in time during the school year are reported.
- **Submission 4** - Students enrolled in ECHS over the summer are reported.
