EXPECTATIONS	CONSEQUENCES
Academic: Maintain a 75 GPA in all high school courses and cumulative 2.0 GPA at San Antonio College. All students must pass SDEV at the college in order to remain in program. (It is the responsibility of the student and parent to monitor grades at SAC via ACES account)	- Exited from Travis ECHS and enrolled at home school.
Behavior: Students are expected to be on their BEST behavior at all times. All disciplinary issues will be handled in accordance with SAISD's Student Code of Conduct Handbook and Alamo Community College Code of Conduct Handbook. Any level III and/or level IV SAISD code of conduct behaviors will result in immediate removal from Travis ECHS. Any behavior that leads to the removal/suspension from San Antonio College will result in immediate removal from Travis ECHS.	- In School Suspension - Suspension - Exited from Travis ECHS and enrolled at home school. (Includes persistent level I and level II behaviors)
Dress Code: 9 th grade students will be required to follow district dress code (for the exception when students attend college classes at SAC). Uniform collared shirts colors are navy blue and white. Khaki colored pants, skirts, shorts. 9 th grade students can also wear a Travis ECHS shirt or college shirt any day of the week. See through clothing is never acceptable.	- Parent conference - Change clothes - Suspension
Tops: All shirts must have sleeves. Strapless tops are not permitted – even with cover. Tanks tops that are 3 fingers in width unless covered by a top or sweater. (Must keep cover on) should always be of appropriate length and fit.	- Parent conference - Change clothes - Suspension
Piercings: <u>Only earrings are approved.</u> All other piercings should NOT BE VISIBLE at any time – regardless of where they are. Earrings that are sharp and long will need approval by Travis Administration.	- Parent conference - Suspension
Pants: Baggy or sagging pants are prohibited. Tight fitting pants (e.g., tights, bicycle pants, Spandex) are prohibited. Clothing with holes, tears, etc. is prohibited.	- Parent conference - Change clothes - Suspension
Hair: Unconventional colors or hairstyles (e.g., Mohawks, spiked hair or designs) causing distractions are not permitted.	- Parent conference - Suspension
Shoes: The following are NEVER permitted: flip flops (anything that flops off your feet), house shoes, slippers, shower shoes, etc.	- Parent conference - Change clothes - Suspension
Safety: Students are to notify administration, staff, or an adult when someone's safety is being questioned and/or violated. Office – 210-738-9830	Student/Parent Conference Detention In School Suspension Exited from Travis ECHS and enrolled at home school.
5+ Absences will lead to student/parent conference. When a student exceeds 10 absences he/she can lose credit for the class. Excessive absences from school may lead to removal from Travis ECHS. 3 Absences from a College Course can lead to automatically being dropped from the rosters and from Travis.
