Summer Homework and Summer Camp Expectations and Consequences

Middle School (MS) Students	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <input type="checkbox"/> All middle school students are to complete summer homework for MS ELA and SS classes—whether she attends Summer PREP/Duke TIP or not. <input type="checkbox"/> MS students taking an AP class are to complete AP summer homework for that class. <input type="checkbox"/> MS students attending Summer PREP/Duke TIP at a local college/university must complete Summer PREP and bring the completion certification by August 3, 2018. <input type="checkbox"/> MS students who start Summer PREP/Duke TIP, but do not complete Summer Prep/Duke TIP, must do ALL summer homework packets. If a MS student attends Summer PREP/Duke TIP AND completes Summer Prep/Duke TIP, these students still need to complete only MS ELA Reading/ENG I summer homework (all of it). <input type="checkbox"/> If a middle school student fails PREP and does not have documentation of having attended tutoring and been in attendance, she is required to complete all summer homework packets. <input type="checkbox"/> Students will submit summer homework as directed in packet by teacher. Read carefully to avoid academic probation. MARK YOUR CALENDARS.
High School (HS) Students	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <input type="checkbox"/> All high school students, whether attending summer PREP/Duke TIP or not, must complete their summer homework. <input type="checkbox"/> Read your summer homework packet for due dates. Due dates can be during summer camps or the first day of school—MARK YOUR CALENDARS. Read carefully to avoid academic probation. <input type="checkbox"/> Be sure to submit your HS Intention form to your PREP teacher.
All students	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <input type="checkbox"/> Summer PREP/Duke TIP Certificates must be presented by August 3, 2018 for verification of grades and attendance. <input type="checkbox"/> Summer PREP/Duke TIP grades will be used as a major course grade in place of summer homework grade—for middle school students only who graduate from PREP/Duke TIP. <input type="checkbox"/> Summer homework will be used as a major course grade during the 1st 9 weeks.
Academic Probation/ Honor Societies	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <input type="checkbox"/> Students, who do not complete their homework, as directed by each teacher, will be placed on academic probation. All items in each packet must be completed by the student and not others. <input type="checkbox"/> All students must follow all Academic Integrity expectations at all times, including the completion of summer homework. Each student is to complete her own summer homework and all work. Each student will submit a signed Academic Integrity Agreement for a grade in Advisory PREP (3rd period). <input type="checkbox"/> Students who do not complete summer homework will not be eligible for consideration into YWLA Honor Societies. <input type="checkbox"/> Students who do not attend summer camps will be placed on academic probation and will not be eligible for consideration into YWLA Honor Societies. <input type="checkbox"/> All students are required to attend their grade level camps as listed below. <u>Students who do not attend will be required to reimburse the school for processing fees for each of the missed required camps and will be placed on academic probation.</u>
Summer Camp Grades	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <input type="checkbox"/> Students will receive an overall summer camp grade for each course for summer homework and other expectations that may include a daily grade for participation and daily assignments, quizzes, tests, etc. Teachers will communicate expectations for grades on the first day of camp. <input type="checkbox"/> Summer homework will be a major grade during the 1st 9 weeks grading period.
