Qualified students may apply for UPREP, a concurrent enrollment program held on the UTSA campus after completing PREP Year 3.

PREP is a national summer program that prepares middle and high school students for advanced studies and careers in STEM fields. Program priorities include improving participation of women and underrepresented minorities in these fields, promoting collaboration between educational institutions and industry, and innovating coursework to develop students' critical thinking skills.
