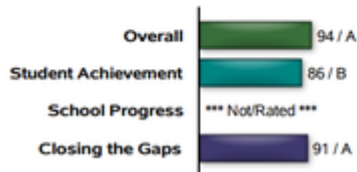

What is SAPP?

The School Age Parenting Program (SAPP) provides support services to pregnant and/or parenting students (males and females) to stay in school, graduate, and learn parenting skills. The program includes: Homebound, SAISD Learning Center, and Social Work services.

Who are we?

Homebound is located in the portable next to the parking lot. Any student in the district who has just delivered a baby is offered up to 6 weeks of Homebound services to keep up with assignments and attendance while postpartum.

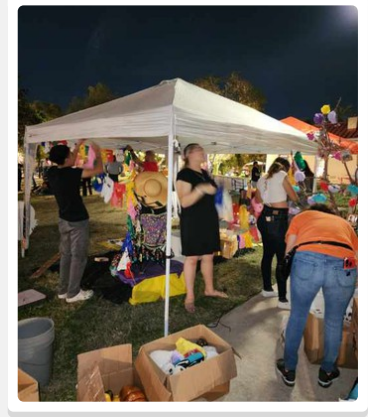
