Message from Principal Robert Loveland

Dear Cooper Academy & Phoenix MC Families:

We had a great first day of school! Our classrooms were filled with excited chatter, laughter, and learning. We know this will be a school year full of possibilities. We had a wonderful time getting to know and starting fresh with all of your bright young faces. Our faculty members were excited to work with your children. We look forward to a fantastic week.

We know from last year that school environments are among the safest places for your child to be during this pandemic. We are continuing to follow stringent prevention strategies, including the recommendation to wear masks, providing regular COVID-19 testing, and ensuring access to the COVID-19 vaccine for those who are eligible.

As you recall, last year we were successfully able to return our students to in-person attendance with a less than 1% positivity rate within our schools.

We recognize that some students may have medical conditions which prevent them from attending school based on the advice of their doctor. Parents may request in-home learning services for their student by accessing this application link. The timeframe for review and processing of applications may be 1-2 weeks. Parents who have submitted an application should not be concerned about their child missing school. If an application is on file, know that we will work diligently to give you a response as quickly as possible and, in the meantime, there will be no disciplinary consequences for students not attending while the inhome instruction application is under review.

In the next few weeks, we will be hosting another opportunity for families to access free school supplies and resources. More information will be shared as details are confirmed. Families soon may begin pre-registering for this second event so that they know the time frame to arrive, easing the distribution of supplies and allowing for crowd control.

For students who need a personal device, please let us know – our campus can assist you with that. And, for students with questions about their device, our Help Desk has extended hours.



SAT, ACT, and PSAT Testing

SAT, ACT, and PSAT is fast approaching. We are asking that all interested 10th, 11th and 12th students students sign-up for one of the aforementioned college entrance examinations by completing the survey found within the attachment below. Our 10th and 11th grade students should sign-up for the PSAT and our 12th grade students should sign up for either the ACT or the SAT. Our school district will provide a School Day testing voucher for one exam. This means that our students will be able to participate in the administration of one exam free of charge. We recommend that all of our students participate in the administration of these examinations. The deadline to sign-up for the exams is Monday, September 13, 2021. The exams will be administered on Tuesday, October 5th (ACT) and October 13 (PSAT and SAT). Volunteer and Mentor Program

Thank you for choosing to volunteer in the San Antonio Independent School District. We hope the time you spend volunteering at SAISD is both fun and rewarding. This includes but not limited to all parent and community volunteers; boosters; chaperones; mentors; tutors; college student observers; business and community partners or any other person wanting to gain access, work or help in the school, (e.g., Student Teachers, Interns, Observers, Agency Nurses, etc.), or who intends to do business with the school or District where students and/or minors are present.

All volunteers must submit an online application through App-Garden.

Complete the <u>volunteer orientation.</u> Complete la <u>orientación de voluntario</u> en español.

Complete the volunteer orientation <u>quiz</u>. Complete la breve <u>prueba</u> en español.

If the applicant successfully clears the background check, reviews the volunteer orientation, and completes the quiz, the application will be automatically approved within 48 business hours. The applicant and the campus will be notified with an approval email.

If the applicant's background check is flagged, he/she will receive an email stating that their application is on hold for further review. The application will then be reviewed by the Volunteer Approval and Denial (VAD) Committee. The applicant will be notified of their approval or denial status within two weeks of the application date.
