Appointments available at school-based clinics

San Antonio ISD's two school-based health centers at Davis and Tafolla middle schools are open for appointments Monday through Friday from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. to meet the needs of the community. The health centers are operated in collaboration with the University Health System, and both centers offer in-person and tele-visit appointments.

The health centers are located in stand-alone portable buildings on the middle school campuses:

- Health Center East at Davis Middle School is located at 4702 E. Houston St. and appointments can be made by calling (210) 644-2050.
- Health Center West at Tafolla Middle School is located at 1303 W. Cesar E. Chavez Blvd. and appointment can be made by calling (210) 644-2000.

The centers provide care for the following health issues:

- Minor acute care (ear or throat infections, asthma, bronchitis)
- Physical exams/well-child checkups
- Primary care
- Immunizations
- Sports physicals
- Health education on nutrition, disease and injury prevention
- Medication prescriptions as needed

Health center staff can assist patients that are underinsured or uninsured make an account with Bexar County's CareLink financial assistance program. Also accepted are private insurance, CHIP, Medicaid, and cash payment arrangements.

Volunteer and Mentor Program

Thank you for choosing to volunteer in the San Antonio Independent School District. We hope the time you spend volunteering at SAISD is both fun and rewarding. This includes but not limited to all parent and community volunteers; boosters; chaperones; mentors; tutors; college student observers; business and community partners or any other person wanting to gain access, work or help in the school (e.g., Student Teachers, Interns, Observers, Agency Nurses,

etc.), or who intends to do business with the school or District where students and/or minors are present.

All volunteers must submit an online application through [App-Garden](#).

If the applicant successfully clears the background check, reviews the volunteer orientation, and completes the quiz, the application will be automatically approved within 48 business hours. The applicant and the campus will be notified with an approval email.

If the applicant's background check is flagged, he/she will receive an email stating that their application is on hold for further review. The application will then be reviewed by the Volunteer Approval and Denial (VAD) Committee. The applicant will be notified of their approval or denial status within two weeks of the application date.
