Please select New Users/Register to begin the registration process.
As you register, please note that all data is case sensitive.

To register and be authenticated, you must enter the following information for one of your children that is currently enrolled in San Antonio ISD:

- Parent/guardian first name
- Parent/guardian last name
- Student birthdate
- Student first name
- Student last name
- Student ID (Contact campus if you do not have)
- Parent/guardian zip code of home address
- Create a user ID (maximum 32 alphanumeric characters)
- Create a password (maximum 64 alphanumeric characters)
- Create a security question & answer (maximum 150 characters)

If the data you provided matches the data in Frontline, you are automatically authenticated and ready to use the Frontline Parent Portal. Once you have authenticated for one of your children, all of your children will appear under this account if they are connected properly in Frontline.

If there is a data mismatch, the authentication process will fail and you will need to contact the campus to resolve the data error. Once the data has been corrected, you can go online to register and be authenticated.

District employees who have students in the District must follow different login instructions. This category of users will visit <https://tinyurl.com/y5pvgw8j> and sign in with their SAISD email user ID and password. If you have any issues logging in or viewing your students, contact your child's campus to have the Parent Portal flag set to activate your account.

El nuevo portal para padres de SAISD es una herramienta de comunicación segura y fácil de usar que permite a los padres/tutores monitorear el progreso de su hijo en tiempo real:

- Vea la asistencia, las calificaciones y el horario de su hijo
- Comuníquese con el maestro de su hijo por correo electrónico
- Reciba alertas y notificaciones en su teléfono

Todos los padres y tutores deberán crear una nueva cuenta antes de que la aplicación funcione.

Seleccione Nuevos usuarios/Registrarse para comenzar el proceso de registro. Al registrarse, tenga en cuenta que todos los datos distinguen entre mayúsculas y minúsculas.

Para registrarse y ser autenticado, debe ingresar la siguiente información de uno de sus hijos que actualmente esté inscrito en San Antonio ISD:

- Nombre del padre/tutor
- Apellido del padre/tutor
- Fecha de nacimiento del estudiante
- Nombre del estudiante
- Apellido del estudiante
- Número de identificación del estudiante (Comuníquese con su escuela si no lo sabe)
- Código postal del hogar del padre/tutor
- Crear un nombre de usuario (Máximo 32 caracteres alfanuméricos)
- Crear una contraseña (64 caracteres alfanuméricos como máximo)
- Crear una pregunta y respuesta de seguridad (Máximo 150 caracteres)

Si los datos que proporcionó coinciden con los datos de Frontline, será autenticado automáticamente y estará listo para usar el Portal de Padres de Frontline. Una vez que se haya autenticado con uno de sus hijos, todos sus hijos aparecerán en esta cuenta, si están conectados correctamente en Frontline.

Si hay una falta de coincidencia de datos, el proceso de autenticación fallará y usted debe comunicarse con la escuela para resolver el error de datos. Una vez que los datos sean corregidos, puede conectarse en línea para registrarse y autenticarse.

Los empleados del distrito que tienen estudiantes en el distrito deben seguir diferentes instrucciones de inicio de sesión. Esta categoría de usuarios visitará esta página <https://tinyurl.com/y5pvgw8j> e iniciará la sesión con el nombre de usuario y contraseña de su correo electrónico de SAISD. Si tiene algún problema para iniciar la sesión o ver a sus estudiantes, comuníquese con la escuela de su hijo para tener la bandera del Portal de Padres configurada para activar su cuenta.

Appointments available at school-based clinics

San Antonio ISD's two school-based health centers at Davis and Tafolla middle schools are open for appointments Monday through Friday from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. to meet the needs of the community. The health centers are operated in collaboration with the University Health System, and both centers offer in-person and tele-visit appointments.

The health centers are located in stand-alone portable buildings on the middle school campuses:

- Health Center East at Davis Middle School is located at 4702 E. Houston St. and appointments can be made by calling (210) 644-2050.
- Health Center West at Tafolla Middle School is located at 1303 W. Cesar E. Chavez Blvd. and appointment can be made by calling (210) 644-2000.

The centers provide care for the following health issues:

- Minor acute care (ear or throat infections, asthma, bronchitis)
- Physical exams/well-child checkups
- Primary care
- Immunizations
- Sports physicals
- Health education on nutrition, disease and injury prevention
- Medication prescriptions as needed

Health center staff can assist patients that are underinsured or uninsured make an account with Bexar County's CareLink financial assistance program. Also accepted are private insurance, CHIP, Medicaid, and cash payment arrangements.

Volunteer and Mentor Program

Thank you for choosing to volunteer in the San Antonio Independent School District. We hope the time you spend volunteering at SAISD is both fun and rewarding. This includes but not limited to all parent and community volunteers; boosters; chaperones; mentors; tutors; college student observers; business and community partners or any other person wanting to gain access, work or help in the school, (e.g., Student Teachers, Interns, Observers, Agency Nurses, etc.), or who intends to do business with the school or District where students and/or minors are present.

All volunteers must submit an online application through [App-Garden](#).

If the applicant successfully clears the background check, reviews the volunteer orientation, and completes the quiz, the application will be automatically approved within 48 business hours. The applicant and the campus will be notified with an approval email.

If the applicant's background check is flagged, he/she will receive an email stating that their application is on hold for further review. The application will then be reviewed by the Volunteer Approval and Denial (VAD) Committee. The applicant will be notified of their approval or denial status within two weeks of the application date.
