### <u> 2016-2017 Course Slips</u>

Even though the first semester is still underway, we are already beginning to plan our course offerings for next school year. Ms. Coss and I will be visiting with students during the first full week of December in order to review the course slips for their grade level. Please keep an eye out for these forms because they do require a parent signature. I encourage you to have a conversation with your child about their goals for next school year and the reality of what they can manage in their schedule. For example, if you know your child needs to have a study hall class in order to stay on top of homework and manage all of the extracurricular demands on her time, make sure she chooses "Academic Mentoring" as one of her course options. Please feel free to contact me with any questions you have about scheduling or graduation credits.

### 8th Grade Parent/Student Advisement Conferences

Conferences have already begun for 8th graders and their parents. If you have not scheduled a conference with our office, please email Ms. Coss at acoss 1@saisd.net as soon as possible so that we can get you on the calendar. During the conference, we will review your child's career interest inventory results, look at 4-year high school plan options, choose a high school endorsement (pathway), and complete the choice slip for incoming 9th graders! Conference times are available throughout the day, and an evening option is available as well.

### Middle School Applications for UTSA PREP Program

Each year, our middle school students complete applications to participate in the UTSA PREP (Prefreshman Engineering Program) program. We have found that students who do participate in PREP start the school year with a solid foundation of skills and content for the school year ahead. PREP is a mathematics-based, academic enrichment program that emphasizes the development of abstract reasoning and problem solving skills. The program helps students prepare for careers in the fields of science, technology, engineering and mathematics (STEM). The PREP program takes place on various college campuses within San Antonio and runs Monday through Thursday, from mid-June to late July.

PREP is currently undergoing changes with regard to their application process and participation fees, so we will not begin rolling out the application until we hear back from them regarding the changes. PREP 2, 3, and 4 participants will be contacted directly by UTSA.


