College Application Season is fully underway! It is important for seniors who have completed their applications to be checking their e-mail or the college website to make sure they have completed and processed everything. Students also need to submit a copy of their acceptance letters to the main office. We must have copies of all letters and scholarship/financial aid letters.

Please ensure that your daughter's FAFSA and CSS Profiles are complete (not all universities require the CSS Profile).

REMINDER: Please set up your daughter's visit to her doctor to receive any necessary immunizations for college. These are mandatory by the universities and must get done.

Junior Parents:

PSAT Scores should arrive in December. Please have your child start preparing for the SAT administration on Saturday, December 1st. Juniors will also be taking the Pre-ACT on Friday, November 9th, but their priority right now should be the SAT. They can utilize SAT/ACT Study Guides or by logging in to Khan Academy or purchasing workbooks for use at school or home.

8th grade Parent/Student Advisement Conferences

On Thursday, November 8th, at 6:00pm, we will be holding a mandatory parent meeting for 8th grade parents in the auditorium. During the meeting, we will review high school graduation conferences and sign up for individual parent/student advisement conferences with Ms. Coss. These conferences will take place after the Thanksgiving holiday. During the conference, we will review your child's career interest inventory results, look at 4-year high school plan options, choose a high school endorsement (pathway), and complete the choice slip for incoming 9th graders! These conferences are required for all 8th grade parents in order to meet state law requirements.

Conference times are available throughout the day. Evening options are available as well.

1. Promote a Growth Mindset - By focusing on a child's efforts in solving a problem, parents can promote a growth mindset. Saying something like "You worked so hard to solve that problem!" promotes a growth mindset where children understand that their hard work led them to success. This mindset helps create the desire to work hard in the future.

2. Encourage Volunteering and Community Service - Volunteering and community service are terrific ways to increase intrinsic motivation through the reward of helping others. Community service will help children develop healthy self-identities.

3. Create a Kind Identity - Parents can foster a kind and caring identity in their child by how they provide feedback. For example, instead of "I'm happy that you are being nice to your sister," parents can say "I'm happy that you are such a kind sister/brother ." As a child's selfidentity emerges, parents can help make sure that kindness is naturally a part of it.

4. Practice, Practice, Practice - It's natural to want to step in and help a child avoid mistakes — that's parental instinct. Yet, making mistakes is an important part of the learning process. Children need time and opportunities to practice social and emotional skills. Each time a child has to figure out a tough situation on his/her own, the child is making important strides forward. Parents should use judgment on how much leeway to give their children and always be there when they really need help.


