Simple toys over high-tech gadgets

A new report by the American Academy of Pediatrics suggests that heavy use of electronic media could actually interfere with children's speech and language development - and even lead to obesity. Dr. Alan Mendelsohn, a pediatrician at NYU Langone Health in New York and co-author of the study, explained that while many parents feel pressured by ads promoting tablet-based toys and games - the best toys for toddlers are old-fashioned hands-on playthings like blocks and puzzles which spark imagination and creativity. Middle School Applications for UTSA PREP Program

YWLA is requiring all 6th graders to apply to the PREP program (It will be optional for 7th and 8th graders). All applications will be online and we will be guiding the students through the application during advisory classes. 
