The PREP summer program identifies middle and high school students who have an interest in science, technology, engineering and mathematics (STEM). It also helps prepare those students for success in advanced studies and careers by providing a challenging academic program that emphasizes the development of abstract reasoning and problem-solving skills. YWLA is **requiring all 6th graders** to apply to the PREP program (It will be optional for 7th and 8th graders). We **strongly encourage** all students to participate in PREP, if admitted.
