

FAFSA

FAFSA Season is here! This is the month we want all of our seniors to file their FAFSA. We will also be checking to see if colleges on their list require additional financial aid forms, such as the CSS Profile. Our internal deadline to complete all of these forms is October 13th. We want to ensure that we take care of any issues that may arise during this process. If you have not set an appointment please make sure to schedule an appointment with Mrs. Lora or Ms. Cash.

Testing for College

6th through 9th grade students will be taking the PSAT 8/9 this year, in lieu of our annual Mock SAT. This test is not something they should stress about – it is simply an opportunity for feedback.

10th and 11th grade students will be taking the PSAT on Wednesday, October 11th. Get a good night's sleep & eat breakfast. The PSAT is a practice test for the SAT, which is one of the tests that colleges use as part of their admission & merit aid decisions. For 11th graders, it's also the qualifying exam for the National Merit & National Achievement Scholarship Programs.

12th grade students will also be taking the official SAT on Wednesday, Oct. 11th. Please make sure your 11th or 12th grade child is doing test prep via Khan Academy or with an SAT/ ACT Practice manual.
