- To set organizational goals and goal progress measures
- Evaluate the CEO or executive director in alignment with the established goals
- To ensure school leaders and partner networks operate in an autonomous & accountable environment
- To establish a routine for monitoring school performance in alignment with targets outlined in the partner contract
- Ensure the organization is fiscally responsible and meeting applicable legal requirements

What are the expectations (time/training commitment) for founding board members?

- All founding board members should be willing to commit approximately two
 hours a week to the organization. (including a monthly progress update calls with the
 CEO or executive director
- Participation in the Lone Star Governance board member training program
