



# Student Safety Protocols



## All students must follow SAISD safety guidelines:

### 1 Health Monitoring Required

- Parents and students should monitor health; students should not attend school if feeling ill
- Daily health checks will be conducted upon student arrival to include temperature screening and symptom checking
- Visitors must have an appointment

### 2 Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) Required

- Face coverings for all students are required. PK-2nd grade students will be provided a clear face shield
- The Texas Education Agency (TEA) has provided face masks for students; however, parents are welcome to provide their own

### 3 Social Distancing Required

- Students should maintain at least 6 feet of separation from other individuals
- Student arrival and drop-off times or locations will be staggered to the maximum extent possible
- Seating in classrooms and buses will be modified to ensure social distancing
- Physical barriers, such as plexiglass, and social distancing guides/signage will be used
- Use of shared spaces such as cafeterias, libraries, and playgrounds will be limited

### 4 Hand Sanitizing and Hand Washing Required

- Upon entering any facility, hands must be sanitized
- Students will be provided extra time throughout the day to wash their hands



*The virus that causes COVID-19 can be spread to others by infected persons who have few or no symptoms. Even if an infected person is only mildly ill, the people they spread it to may become seriously ill or even die, especially if that person is 65 or older with pre-existing health conditions that place them at higher risk of serious consequences if they contract the virus. Because of the hidden nature of this threat, everyone should rigorously follow the practices specified in these protocols, all of which facilitate a safe and measured reopening. The virus that causes COVID-19 is still circulating in our communities. We should continue to observe practices that protect everyone, including those who are most vulnerable.*
