ABSENCES

It's the LAW!

Any student between the ages of 6 and 19 years of age **MUST** attend school until they receive a diploma.

It only counts if you are **IN** the classroom on time. Your teacher must count you **PRESENT** when he/she takes role.

01 Credit denial



- 9 Absences allowed 1st and 8th pd
- 4 absences allowed 2nd - 7th pd

02 Seat Time

- Unexcused absences must be made up.
- All hours must be made up by the end of the semester.

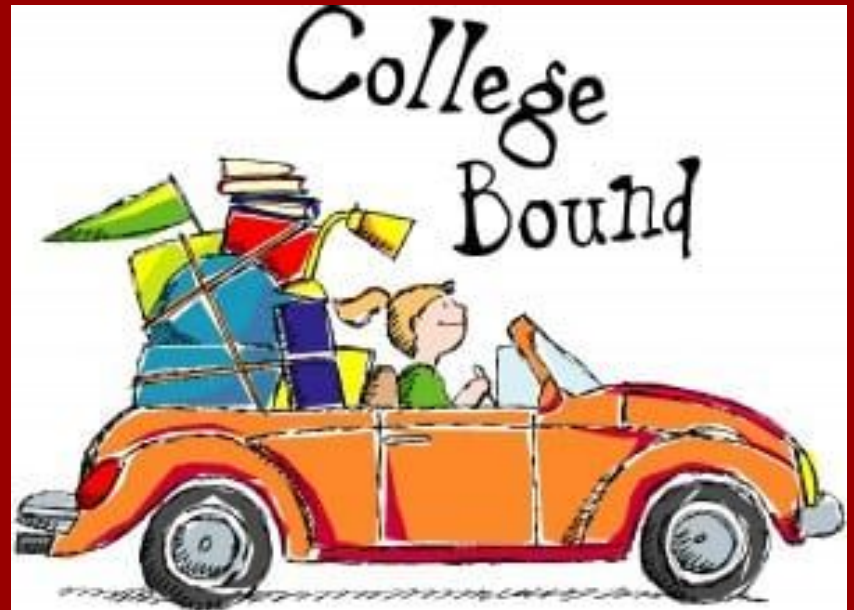

- Every student in here has the right to learn in a safe learning environment that is conducive to learning.



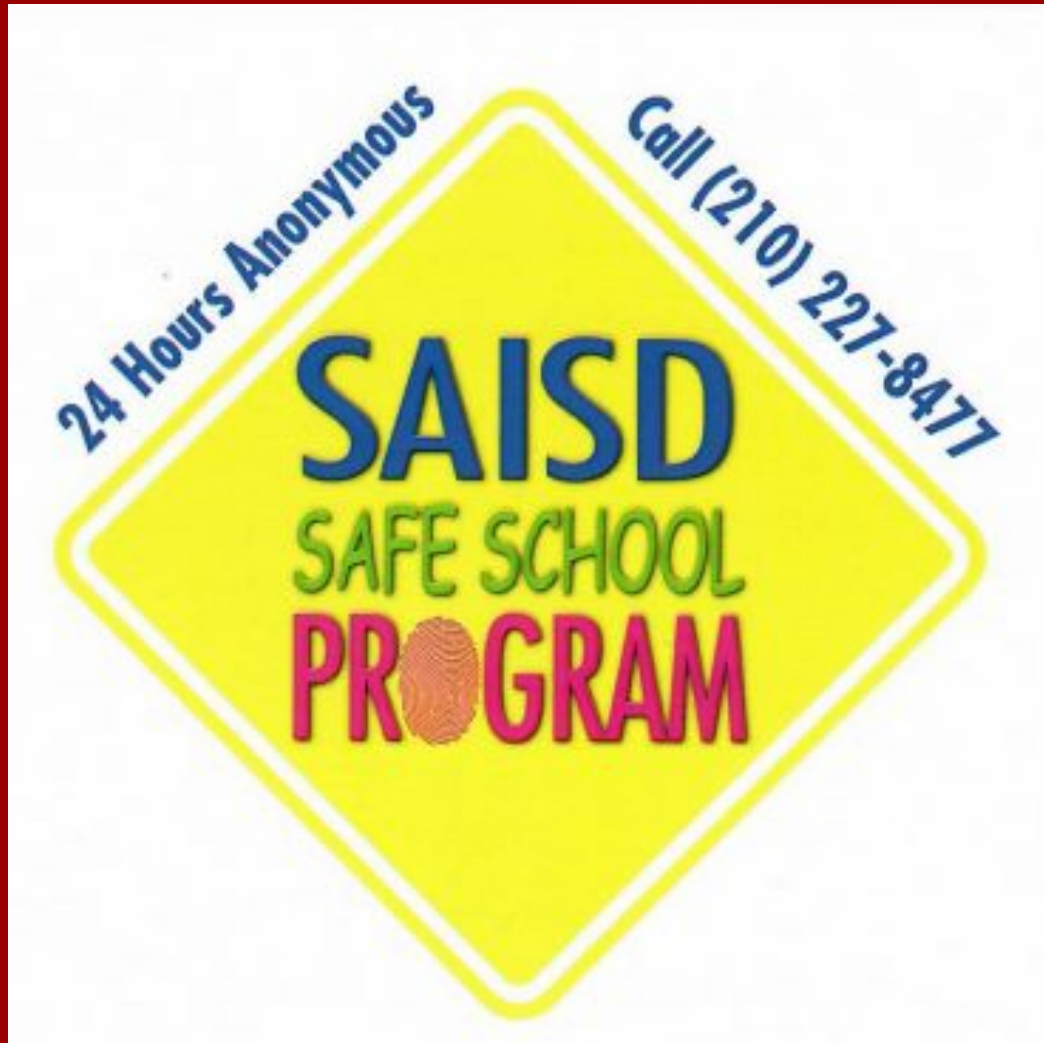

Bus Behavior Expectations

- Students are expected to adhere to all campus expectations for behavior while riding to and from school.
- Violations of behavior expectations will be reported by bus drivers and reviewed by campus administrators and police if necessary.
- Students can lose bus riding privileges temporarily or permanently based on the infraction.

RULE 3: DRESS CODE

- A shirt with fabric that touches the waistband in the front, back, and sides under the arms.
- Pants/jeans or the equivalent (skirt, sweatpants, leggings, a dress, shorts) **free of rips** that expose skin or undergarments.
- Shoes.

The district **prohibits** pictures, emblems or writing on clothing that:

- Are **lewd, offensive, vulgar or obscene**
- Advertise or depict **tobacco products, alcoholic beverages, drugs**, or any other substance prohibited under board policy FNCF (LEGAL)
- Depict **gang**-related attire

Appropriate footwear must be worn. **Prohibited** footwear includes:

- Footwear with **toes reinforced** with steel, hard plastics, or similar materials.
- **Flip Flops, beach sandals, or other open-toed shoes** that do not have straps to secure them.
