
It's the LAW!

All students must have a pass. "No excuses"


Students must make up the <u>SEAT</u>

Bus Behavior Expectations

- Students are expected to adhere to all campus expectations for behavior while riding to and from school.
- Violations of behavior expectations will be reported by bus drivers and reviewed by campus administrators and police if necessary.

RULE 3: DRESS CODE



- A shirt with fabric that touches the waistband in the front, back, and sides under the arms.
- Pants/jeans or the equivalent (skirt, sweatpants, leggings, a dress, shorts) free of rips that expose skin or undergarments.
- · Shoes.

The district prohibits pictures, emblems or writing on clothing that:

- · Are lewd, offensive, vulgar or obscene
- Advertise or depict tobacco products, alcoholic beverages, drugs, or any other substance prohibited under board policy FNCF (LEGAL)
- Depict gang-related attire

Appropriate footwear must be worn. Prohibited footwear includes:

- Footwear with toes reinforced with steel, hard plastics, or similar materials.
- Flip Flops, beach sandals, or other open-toed shoes that do not have straps to secure them.
