

Longfellow Middle School Admissions Policy



Longfellow Middle School of San Antonio Independent School district has no special admissions requirements outside those mandated by San Antonio Independent School District attendance zone admission guidelines in which a student attends a campus based on their address of residence. (See <u>SAISD School Finder Link</u>)

Students must enroll at Longfellow Middle School at which time they become part of the International Baccalaureate Middle Years Program (IB MYP). The majority of our students are from our neighborhood, however if a student lives outside of the zone for admission and would like to attend Longfellow Middle School, they can enroll with Principal approval.

Longfellow Middle School wholeheartedly believes in the Middle Years Program and how it can benefit all students. We believe that all applicants should understand that the faculty and administration at Longfellow Middle School expect student applicants to be eager and motivated learners that will willingly commit to the academic rigors of the MYP curriculum. We also expect all out-of-zone applicants to commit to Standards and Practices that govern the implementation of the IB program. Such students may risk returning to their home-zoned school for failure to demonstrate high standards of academic integrity and exemplary conduct.

All students at Longfellow Middle School follow current district <u>SAISD Student Bill of</u> <u>Rights and Code of Conduct</u>.
