Course Description

Welcome to Biology! This course will allow students to better understand their relationship to the "living world" around them. This course covers the important aspects of biology related to a variety of topics that include: the characteristics of living things; structures and functions of cells and viruses; growth and development of organisms: cells, tissues, and organs; nucleic acids and genetics: biological evolution; taxonomy; metabolism and energy transfers in living organisms; living systems; homeostasis; ecosystems; and plants, animals and the environment. While studying each of the various topics, students will have a specific approach to the subject in laboratory experiments.
