**Course description:**

Grade level 11

The Cosmetology I program is an industrial education course for students in 11<sup>th</sup> grade. This curriculum has been designed in compliance with the rules of the Texas Department of Licensing and Regulation and public secondary programs for high school students. The intent of the program is to provide students with the required four modules and the skills necessary for students to successfully pass the cosmetologist state board operator's examination. The program will also provide students with a better understanding of the knowledge skills and training needed to succeed in the cosmetology profession.

**Course requirements:**



Tests are given on each unit of study. Students will work together on projects or individually. Skills USA is a student organization, students will be encouraged to participate on a District State and National level. Students must have their **own kit** to be able to perform their practical work. Students will be able to purchase their cosmetology kits at Sally's Beauty Supply Store. Students having their own kit are encouraged to take their kits home on weekends for further practicing. It is **necessary that students study their Theory intensively**. Students must have completed and passed the four modules in order to advance to the next level.

Students will not Advance next year to **cosmetology II** if the following are not met:

1. Disruptive Behavior (fighting, attendance).
2. Not Passing a Module
3. Constant referrals.
4. Not participating in class or program activities.
5. In the case that there are too many students entering cosmetology I. Students must make at least a 70 for semester grade. **Please be aware that not all students will advance. So it imperative that a student make at least a 70 or be prepared to be removed from Class.**
6. Failing 9- weeks or semester.

**Policies:**

3. Students will be allowed and encouraged to stay after school in order to complete any unfinished work as well as makeup hours
4. Assignments missed must be completed within the time framed indicated below
  - a) Homework- two days
  - b) Test- one week after school
  - c) Class work- two days
  - d) Projects - one week

**Grade determinants**

60% daily grades (include participation /attendance/ projects/ daily assignments)

40% assessment (includes weekly quizzes, written test, and semester exam)



## Classroom & lab rules

- Be inside the classroom before tardy Bell Rings.
- No food or drinks in class or lab (no chewing gum).
- Take care of restroom Necessities before class begins (before lecture).
- Follow the student code of conduct.
- Students will show respectful Behavior towards teacher and classmates at all times. Failure to do so will result in disciplinary action. (talking in class or talking when others are talking)
- **Appearance must be neat and clean and becoming to someone in the beauty industry.**
- Need available each day: lined paper, pencils and a good attitude.
- Do not enter the teacher's office without permission or invitation.
- Telephone is for business use only and emergency situations upon teachers consent. (That includes cell phones)
- No bad language will be tolerated in the classroom
- Personal marks on the neck (hickeys) are discouraged and if detected students will be asked to cover it with a Band-Aid during class time.
- Students are responsible for the content of their own kit, no borrowing of school supplies for home use. This is viewed as stealing.
- Each day lab stations and chairs must be sanitized. Floors at stations must be swept. All assigned duties must be completed each day. Class will be dismissed when the lab is clean. The bell doesn't dismiss you, the teacher does.
- Students must wear proper closed shoes. No flip-flops or sandals.

Parents, please keep in mind that your child must have at least completed



Module I,Module II,Module III and Module IV by the end of the school year 2025 to continue in the cosmetology program next year and at least with a 70% average for the semester. Students must make every absence during the course to make up for missed work class for cosmetology. **If your child does not meet requirements changes are that the student will not be able to continue the course.** For your child to be successful I will need your cooperation to make sure that your child is wearing the correct school uniform. Please make doctor and dental appointments for your child after school or school holidays. We are preparing your child for a career in cosmetology and to become a productive citizen in the community. Your help is appreciated in this area. Failure of your child to comply with school policies will result in missing module information. Together we can make your child's dream reality to become a licensed cosmetologist.
