Course Description:

Students enrolled in the learning lab are enrolled in one or more programs on the Edgenuity system as determined by their academic teams. Students are expected to complete all aspects of all programs they are enrolled in while part of the Edgenuity class. Edgenuity will be utilized as course recovery, course remediation, or course substitution. Credit will be determined by student's performance.

Class Expectations:

#1- Be Polite (Respectful!)

...of yourself, of your teacher, of your peers, of school rules/policies, of others' property, etc.

2- Be Punctual!

Avoid tardies and excessive absences.

#3- Be Prepared!

Come to class with everything you will need to succeed.

#4- Be Positive!

Don't put yourself down and don't put others down.

#5- Be Productive (True to Yourself!)

Give 100% effort in all that you do! Remind yourself that **YOU CAN SUCCEED!**

Student Responsibilities:

- Sign in on time as soon as you enter the class.
- Take your numbered card for your laptop and put your phone in its place.
- Login and begin working as soon as you enter the class.
- Check reports to view progress.
- Stay on task and ask for help as needed. I am here as an extra resource. I will help you as long as it is not during a test or quiz.
- All Exams must be completed under teacher supervision in class.
- You may access the learning activities at home or in other areas of the school.
- Your grade is determined as follows:
 - o Learning Path Report
A learning path report will be generated on a regular basis to determine your grade.
 - o Weekly Progress Report
Simply being in credit recovery **DOES NOT** mean that you will automatically earn the credit. It requires hard work and a dedication to learning, staying focused, and passing your tests.

Specific Computer Expectations:

- No food or drinks in class during regular hours, especially around computers.
- No use of internet during Edgenuity class unless instructed by your teacher.
- No listening to music, playing games or watching videos. **NO STREAMING!**
- Must be involved in lessons/assignments entire time allotted for Edgenuity class! (No slacking off!)
- **No use of proxy servers or other programs/devices that bypass security settings/internet.**

Consequences for Not Meeting Expectations:

First offense- generally results in a verbal warning and a note in student’s file.

Second offense- generally results in verbal warning, note in student’s file, and a call/e-mail home.

Third offense- generally results in verbal warning, note in student’s file, call home, and write up that is sent to administration for disciplinary action.

****Note:** If a serious disciplinary offense occurs, the teacher reserves the right to deal with the situation in a manner and /or order contrary to the above stated. Each student will be dealt with objectively and fairly. All students will be held to class and school policies.

Grading System:

Students must maintain an average of at least a 70 on all work completed in Edgenuity Credit Recovery and a 80 in Edgenuity Attainment. Students will get credit for a course when it is complete.

Tutoring and Contact Information:

I will make myself available for tutoring or additional Edgenuity help before school whenever possible. It is best to set up an appointment for tutoring in advance. I want ALL students to succeed, so I strongly encourage students to ask questions both inside and outside the classroom.
