
## How to Calculate Your Grades ( )



The school year is made up of four-Nine Weeks Periods (a total of 36 weeks of school). They are divided as such:


- 1<sup>st</sup> Nine Weeks: August-October
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Nine Weeks: October- December (Semester Exam)
- 3<sup>rd</sup> Nine Weeks: December-March
- 4<sup>th</sup> Nine Weeks: March-May (Semester Exam)



Recall that not all assignments carry the same weight. Tests and quizzes are worth 40% of your grade and classwork, homework, daily grades, etc., are worth 60% of your grade. **Turn in all your work on time and study for all you tests and quizzes! EVERYTHING COUNTS!** 

The 1st and 2<sup>nd</sup> Nine Weeks Periods are added and divided by 2 to calculate the 1<sup>st</sup> SEMESTER Grade. The 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Nine Weeks Periods are added and divided by 2 to calculate the 2<sup>nd</sup> SEMESTER Grade. At the end of the school year, each SEMESTER Grade is then added together, divided by 2, and the FINAL Grade is obtained for the course.

If you already have a grade for one of the nine weeks, you can calculate what your next 9 weeks grade should be to earn the SEMESTER grade you want. For example:
