Jeans/Pants/Shorts/Skirts (All Grade Levels)	Shirts (All Grade Levels)
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ Jogger styles pants/ sweats are not allowed ■ Ripped jeans can not show any skin above the knee. ■ Pajama clothing is not allowed unless stated on special dress days ■ No oversized or baggy clothing – clothes must fit appropriately, and pants will be worn at the waistline (no sagging) ■ Undergarments of any type must not be visible including shorts that are worn under pants. ■ All skirts, skorts and shorts must be at a minimum of fingertip length or longer. ■ No leggings, tights, or bike shorts are permitted. ■ Hoods cannot be worn on the head inside the building. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ No crop-top shirts or jackets will be allowed ■ Shirts must not portray inappropriate language, symbols, gestures or suggestive use of drugs, alcohol or violence. ■ Tank tops, spaghetti straps, halter-tops will not be allowed.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ It is recommended that all backpacks be clear ■ 6th-8th grade are not allowed to bring backpacks 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ Phones are not allowed to be used during school hours ■ Elementary: Phones should be turned off and stored in student's backpack ■ Middle School: Phones will be turned into the classroom teacher at the beginning of school, locked in a closet, and returned to students at the end of the school day. ■ (Phones that go off or are being used within the school will be confiscated by school personnel and must be collected by parent or guardian.) ■ (Note district policy re: phone fines) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ Wireless earbuds will not be allowed in school at any time. Headphones or headsets will be provided by campus for classroom work. ■ No gaming systems will be allowed on campus. (ex. Nintendo Switch)
<p>★ All unallowable items will be confiscated by administration and must be picked up by the parent or guardian by 4:00 pm. Items that are not picked up by this time will need to be picked up the next day.</p>		

Campus Expectations (All Grade Levels)		
Hallways	Restrooms	Lunches
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students will be silent while walking in the hallways at ALL times. • Students in the hallway without their teacher/class present, MUST have a pass from a class or written pass from a staff member. • ALL staff must be present in the hallways while their students are transitioning to ensure student safety. • Students will walk on the right hand side of the hallways and staircases in a single-file line. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Only ONE student at a time per class can leave class to use the restroom. • Students MUST have the designated restroom pass from their classroom with them. • Students must sign out of their class to use the restroom using the provided QR code. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students are expected to enter the cafeteria with their teacher in a silent, single-file line from the hallway. • Students are silent while waiting in line for their food. • Students are permitted to talk with classmates at their assigned table at a controlled volume. • Assign students at each table to ensure the area around their table is clean before dismissing the table. • Students exit the cafeteria silently with their teacher.
